Functions: Describing past experiences – Talking about recent events – Talking about obligation, prohibition, necessity

Grammar: Present Perfect vs Past Simple - Modal verbs: Must vs Have to - Have to/Don't have to – Must/Mustn't

Unit 13: Live and learn

Functions: Talking about actions starting in the past and going on in the present – Offers and requests

Grammar: Present Perfect with For and Since – How long - Indefinite Pronouns: compounds with some/any/no/every

Unit 14: Stay connected

Functions: Talking about obligation, prohibition, necessity – Give advice - Express opinions

Grammar: Modal verbs: Must vs Have to - Have to/Don't have to – Must/Mustn't – Should/Shouldn't

Unit 15: A festive air

Functions: Describe on going actions in the past - Talking about past experience – Talking about past habits

Grammar: Past Continuous - Past Simple vs Past Continuous – When and While

Unit 18: What if...?

Function: Talking about a real situation likely to happen in the future - Talking about hypothesis unlikely to happen - Talking about unreal situations in the past and their results - Talking about events before past events

Grammar: IF clauses - First conditional – Present Conditional - Second Conditional – Revision Simple present and Simple past – Revision will/won't future - Third Conditional – Past Conditional
